5th Advanced Workshop on Concrete Pavements

Preceding the 13th International Conference on Concrete Pavements Minneapolis, MN

Sustainability and Resilience Innovative Materials and Design Pavement Design and Analysis Construction Pavement Assessment and Management

Objective

This international symposium aims to bring together experts in concrete materials characterization, mechanics, modeling, and design to critically discuss and develop concepts to address existing limitations, lack of knowledge, and most importantly, the future direction for improvement of concrete pavement analysis, design, and construction.

Workshop Background

This symposium is the fifth in a series of fundamental workshops sponsored by the International Society for Concrete Pavements (ISCP) preceding the International Conference on Concrete Pavements. Starting this year, the workshop will be upgraded into an International Symposium to differentiate it from the various workshops offered at the main conference. The first in this series of encounters was held in Copper Mountain, Colorado, USA in August 2005 while the second and third were held, respectively, in Berkeley, California, USA in August 2008 and in Lac Delage, Quebec, Canada in July 2012. The latest and fourth workshop in this series was held in Round Top, Texas, USA in August 2016.

Workshop Format

- ✓ Each presenter will make a 10-minute presentation and the session chair will lead a subsequent 20-minute group discussion on the topic.
- ✓ At the end of the Symposium, recommendations will be developed for presentation at the 13th International Conference on Concrete Pavements.

- Initial extended abstract submittal April 15
- Extended abstract reviewed and notification of acceptance May 15
- Early bird registration deadline June 1
- Final extended abstract submitted July 1
